HOMICIDE - 0

ASSAULT -3* 1 incident of Domestic violence was reported in Val Verde. *A man was arrested for swinging a metal pipe at a neighbor who he accused of kissing his wife. *After being detained by responding Deputies, the man's wife told the Deputies that he had also physically abused her a week prior. The man was arrested for 2 counts of Assault.

BURGLARY -8

Residential -7 *Since the last reporting period there has been an additional 7 Residential Burg's. Suspects are knocking on the front door of houses to ensure no one is home, after several moments if no one answers they attempt to make entry through the rear of the house. In two of these incidents, the suspects were seen by homeowners who didn't answer the door. Both reported seeing 2 male blacks running to a near bye waiting vehicle. The vehicle description in a silver or grey SUV possibly a Lexus or a Toyota.

Commercial -1 * An employee at a local store was caught on camera voiding sales slips and pocketing the money. When interviewed she admitted to having done this several different times on different days. The total amount embezzled was just over \$350

LARCENY -7 * There were two reported thefts from locked vehicles. An RV in the Castaic RV storage yard was broken into, an air compressor and tools were stolen. * An unlocked vehicle parked on Rainer Rd had a set of keys taken from the center console. *A woman dropped her phone at Ralph's and didn't realize it till she got home. She ran the GPS application and saw that her phone was taken into Val Verde where it lost reception. *On Romero Canyon, a man caught his neighbor stealing \$5500 worth of tools and cinder blocks off of his property. *A folding chair was taken from the front porch of the Sr. Living complex in Castaic. *A Knox box and Realtor sign was taken from the front yard off of Countryside Street. *A Castaic resident saw what she believed to be her broach in a Lancaster Pawn shop, she verified that hers was missing from home and reported it to the Lancaster Sheriff station. The victim stated that she has helped homeless people for the last 10 years and is unsure who could have taken it. It was last seen by the Victim in her bathroom drawer in 2002.
