

Castaic Area Town Council To Hold Election

On November 6, 2010, the Castaic Area Town Council will hold its election. Candidates must be 18 years of age, a registered voter and a resident of Castaic for at least one year prior to the election date. Council members serve the community as volunteers.

Councilpersons are required to attend two meetings per month and will represent their respective districts in advising Supervisor Michael Antonovich of the Los Angeles Board of Supervisors on issues involving the Castaic community.

The council is comprised of five regions within the 100 square miles of Castaic and its various communities, including Val Verde. There is one council seat for each of the five regions to be filled in the 2010 election and candidates must reside in the region they represent. Council members serve for a term of four years.

In order to run, a candidate must provide the council with a letter outlining his/her reason for wanting to run and confirming that they meet the requirement set forth above along with their qualifications. Additionally, a \$25 nonrefundable application fee must accompany the application.
